**ORDINANCE NO. 2892**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE BOND ELECTION HELD NOVEMBER 6, 2007.**

**WHEREAS**, notice of said election was actually given by the City as required by law; and

**WHEREAS**, said election was duly and legally held on November 6, 2007, in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of said election have been certified and returned by the proper judges and clerks thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City has considered the returns of said election held November 6, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, the election returns, duly and legally made, showed that there were 3,915 votes cast at the election and that each proposition in the election received the following votes:

The issuance of \$6,350,000 general obligation bonds for park improvements		

<b><u>Bond Proposition 5</u></b>	<b>Yes 2,831 (73%)</b>	<b>No 1,048 (27%)</b>
The issuance of \$3,400,000 general obligation bonds for a new animal shelter facility		

<b><u>Bond Proposition 6</u></b>	<b>Yes 2,753 (71%)</b>	<b>No 1,101 (29%)</b>
The issuance of \$2,050,000 general obligation bonds for improvements to the Central Service Center		

<b><u>Bond Proposition 7</u></b>	<b>Yes 2,641 (68%)</b>	<b>No 1,223 (32%)</b>
The issuance of \$2,000,000 general obligation bonds for Economic Development		

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1**

That it is determined the results of the November 6, 2007 Bond Election as canvassed and tabulated reflect the expressed desires of the qualified voters of the City.

**SECTION 2**

That the City Council declares and orders that Bond Propositions 1-6 are adopted by the receiving of a majority of the qualified votes in said election.

That this ordinance becomes effective from and after the date of its passage.
