The Neighborhood Advisory Commission (NAC) advises the City Council on policies and strategies related to the development, preservation and enhancement of neighborhoods throughout the city of Carrollton. The Commission is composed of nine (9) citizens appointed by the City Council.

 - Raising funding amount per grant (from \$5,000 – to \$10,000 - \$20,000) - **approved**
 - Raising annual funding allotment (currently \$15,000 annually to \$45,000 or more) - **approved**
