AND THE LEANEST OF THEM ALL: That's Little Elm (pop: 42,504), which boasts 67 government employees on its payroll per 10,000 residents.

THE METHODOLOGY: Only cities with more than 30,000 residents were included in our analysis with one exception: Haltom City (pop: 44,361), which was unable to provide the requested information in an editable electronic format by print deadline. All employees appearing on cities' payroll — including part-time and temporary personnel — were included in our calculations. Ratios have been rounded to the nearest whole number for ease of reading.

THE AVERAGE NORTH TEXAS CITY HAS 98 EMPLOYEES PER 10,000 RESIDENTS, according to analysis of payroll information provided to the Dallas Business Journal by local cities from information requests submitted in August 2017.
