## People Helping People Program



Grants up to \$5,000 are  
available to homeowners  
for minor repairs to  
home exteriors



## About the Program

The People Helping People Program provides assistance to low income homeowners for essential repairs when the owner-occupant lacks sufficient resources of their own. All work is done by volunteers in the community. Through this program, the homeowner can get assistance with repairs that can be completed for \$5,000 or less..

### Eligible Projects

- Painting a house
- Minor siding repair
- Minor exterior work on houses
- Code violation repairs

### Ineligible Projects

Repairs that are only cosmetic in nature are not eligible. NOTE: Cosmetic repairs may be carried out under the program in small areas only when they are necessary to complete other repairs.

- Fence repair
- Yard work
- Tree trimming

## Who Qualifies?

Homeowners may be eligible if all of the following conditions are met:

- The applicant is a U.S. citizen or legal resident alien.
- The home is a single-family dwelling unit located within Carrollton City limits.
- The applicant owns and occupies the property as his/her principal residence on a year-round basis and has no intention to rent or sell the property.
- The applicant qualifies based on income level.
- All payments for City-provided utilities and property taxes are current for the property.
- There are no federal liens on the property.

## Program Limitations

There are limits to what the grant funds can address.

- It is not assistance for home sellers.
- Assistance is not a remodeling service.
- Assistance is not for rental homes.

## How to Apply for Assistance
