Youth Volunteer of the Year Award

The Carrollton Youth Volunteer of the Year Award is for distinguished service to a City of Carrollton department, program, school or organization. Examples are Boy/Girl Scouts, School Programs, City departments, etc. Any winner from the previous year are ineligible to win for the next two years. Winners can be a part of the award selection for the upcoming volunteer awards.

Award Selection

1. The award selection is based on the nominee's volunteer efforts and commitment of time, accomplishments, community impact, and enhancement of the lives of others, as described on the nomination form.
2. The Selection Committee selects recipient of the award, based on the selection criteria.
3. The recipient of the award is selected based on merit – without regard to race, religion, gender, national origin, or physical/mental disability.
4. The award will be announced at the 13th Annual Citizen's Evening at the Carrollton Senior Center, Texas Ballroom.

Eligibility

1. Nominees should be 10-17 years of age and have been active in the 2019 calendar year.
2. Nominees must have been engaged in volunteer activities for a minimum of one year in the City of Carrollton and have benefited the Carrollton community in a substantial or unique way.
3. Nominees must volunteer for a city department, city program, school programs, or organizations that benefit the city.
4. Students receiving course credits for their volunteer activities are ineligible unless the nomination is based upon service that extends beyond the course requirements, in which case it must be clearly indicated in the nomination statement.
5. Nomination cannot be based upon court-mandated community service.
