The City of Carrollton is excited to announce the 2020 Carrollton Cares volunteer recognition program. The city cannot operate without our volunteers' extraordinary efforts and dedication. Volunteers provide our community with a sense of humanitarianism. They build and implement important programs that could enhance our community. Carrollton is grateful for the quality and quantity of the volunteers we have, and we know that many of our important programs and services would not be possible without them.

Annual Neighborhood Leadership Award

The Annual Neighborhood Leadership Award is designed to recognize adults in the Carrollton community who have taken a proactive role in addressing the needs of Carrollton residents. Examples of volunteer efforts are beautification projects, outstanding board leadership or accountability, youth projects, church community outreach projects, crime watch, inter-cultural projects, and social causes. Nominees can serve with neighborhood associations, churches, non-profits, PTA's, or any other self-organizing group in the City of Carrollton. Their efforts must have contributed outstanding service to their community. Any winner from the previous year are ineligible to win for the next two years. Winners can be a part of the award selection for the upcoming volunteer awards.

Award Selection

The award selection is based on the nominee's volunteer efforts, commitment of time, accomplishments, community impact, and enhancement of the lives of others.

1. The Selection Committee selects the recipient of the award, based on the selection criteria.
2. The recipient of the award is selected based on merit – without regard to race, religion, gender, national origin, or physical/mental disability.
3. The award will be announced at the 13th Annual Citizens' Evening at Carrollton Senior Center, Texas Ballroom.

Eligibility

1. Nominees should be at least 18 years of age.
2. Nominees must have been engaged in volunteer activities for a minimum of one year in the City of Carrollton and benefited the community in a substantial or unique way.
3. Nominees must have volunteered in the City of Carrollton.
4. Students receiving course credits for their volunteer activities are ineligible unless the nomination is based upon volunteer service that extends beyond the course requirements, in which case it must be clearly indicated in the nomination statement.
5. Nomination cannot be based upon court-mandated community service.
6. Nominee must have been active in the 2019 calendar year.
