

## Polling Place Safety Measures

Election workers will be encouraged to allow a limited number of voters inside the polling location during voting hours.

Polling places are set up according to suggested social and physical distance guidelines where possible to allow for 6 feet between voters.

Floor markings will be provided for distancing and traffic control, and machines will be placed at least six feet apart.

Election workers will be issued KN-95 masks. Workers may wear their own higher grade masks if desired. The flat disposable face masks will also be available for workers as well as voters if they should need one.

Face shields will be available to election workers who wish to wear them.

Plexiglas shields will be provided at check-in stations, similar to check-out at retail stores.

Voters are encouraged to bring their own pen. All pens that are provided will be disinfected after each use.

Poll workers are encouraged to minimize handling of voters ID's. Where possible, card readers for Drivers Licenses will be placed where voters may scan their own licenses rather than hand them to an election worker to scan.

Disposable ballot marking devices (Q-tips) will be provided to every voter for use on the touch screen voting machines.

Additional voting machines will be provided for curbside voting for those who don't wish to enter the vote center.

Workers will be trained on sanitation procedures.
