



**The City of Carrollton recognizes the Carrollton
Women's Club for 100 years of Service.**

On April 29, 1920, five women held the first meeting of the Carrollton Social and Civic Club. The club was organized "for the benefit of our town." The name was changed to Carrollton Women's Club in 1972. In 1980, CWC provided its first college scholarship to qualifying female high school seniors residing in Carrollton. As of 2020, the 100th year of the club, \$371,200 has been awarded in scholarships. CWC members have also donated over \$54,000 to other local agencies for the benefit of the community. All of these charitable actions were recognized by the City of Carrollton in 2019 when the Carrollton Women's Club received the Outstanding Community Organization Award.
