

Project Summary Sheet: Villages of Greenway Park HOA NEMG 2016 Median Enhancement Project

Background: The Villages of Greenway Park (VOGP) neighborhood is 17 years old and is represented by a mandatory Homeowners' Association. VOGP intends to enhance the neighborhood along the Rosemeade corridor by replacing the median endcaps at Greenway Parkway and Brookside Drive within the public right-of-way. VOGP residents will feel a sense of pride and belonging to the City.

Proposal: The scope of this project focuses on intersections to give the neighborhood a fresher and updated look all while enhancing the safety of those intersections. Intersections included are Rosemeade Parkway and Greenway Park Drive and Rosemeade Parkway and Brookside Drive.

Budget/Materials/Labor: The total budget for this project is \$8,494.42. Of this sum, the grant request from the Neighborhood Advisory Commission is \$5,662.95. The Villages of Greenway Park Homeowners Association will contribute organization and labor to carry out this project. Neighbors have volunteered their time and skills as "sweat equity" by removing overgrown shrubs and adding native plants, boulders and stones, and 4 crepe Myrtle trees with irrigation.

Neighborhood Advisory Commission (NAC) Recommendations: On August 11, 2016, the NAC discussed the proposal and voted on a recommendation. The Villages of Greenway Park Homeowners Association proposal was approved for recommendation with a unanimous vote of 8 approvals.
